Question 1

Level 3 10/10

- There is a clear indication of how the decision about the activity was made and a brief indication of research and enquiry methods.1
- Both local and national perspectives are shown.2
- Division of roles of individuals in the group is clearly shown. 3
- A clear link is made between the activity and all the themes featured in Unit 1.4
- Knowledge and understanding is clearly communicated and presented in the form of a coherent personal view, supported by appropriate evidence.

Question 2

Level 3 15/15

- The student has clearly communicated directly with two people in a position of influence and the meetings can be authenticated.1
- Several different viewpoints are referred to and examined.2
- The view of the student is clear and she has tried to persuade others. 3
- The reasons for people having different viewpoints are explored in detail.4

Question 3

Level 3 15/15

- The plan of action and its delivery are clear.1
- There is detailed evidence of activity including the power point presentation and the article written for the school newsletter.2
- High level skills and understanding are demonstrated when participating in action.3
- The case for action is informed and the action appropriate. Individual responsibilities and actions are clearly recognised.4
- The evidence presented underlines the excellence of the action taken.5

Question 4

Level 3 10/10

- The quality of writing throughout the submission is of the highest quality and is consistent in demonstrating fluency and coherence.
- There is excellent knowledge and understanding of how the action taken applied both locally and nationally.
- The student has shown the influences on her own view with great clarity and her evaluation has led to reasoned and revealing conclusions.
